

Procedures for Volunteers

All the required forms and training are available in the parish office or on our website: www.olos.us.

Before you can serve as a volunteer you must:

- Review A Statement of Policy for the Protection of Children and Youth
- Review the Code of Conduct for Church Personnel of the Archdiocese of Baltimore
- Complete and **sign** a volunteer application. References are not required if you will not have substantial contact with children.

If you are **18 years or older** and will have substantial contact with children you must also:

- Complete the required training regarding child abuse and protection of children. This can be done online, see below for instructions, or can be arranged by contacting the parish office.
- Supply three (3) references on the volunteer application
- Complete and sign Consent Form for Criminal History Screening (must be done every five years)

Or if you are **14 to 17 years old** and will have substantial contact with children you must also:

- View a video entitled "Worthy of the Call" which can be arranged by contacting the parish office.
- Supply three (3) references on the volunteer application
- Sign the volunteer application **and have a parent sign also.**

The training takes about an hour-and-a-half but can be paused and restarted at any time. You will answer some questions about the material and get a certificate to print.

Return all the completed forms and the certificate to the parish office, preferably in a sealed envelope addressed to Jo Massino.
